Eligibility

- Highly-driven, passionate, and civic-minded nutrition leader
- Registered Nutritionist-Dietitian
- Filipino citizen
- Not more than 45 years old for PhD; not more than 35 years old for MS at the time of application
- Accepted to PhD Human Nutrition or MS Applied Nutrition Programs of UPLB Graduate School
- Passed the screening and interview of UPLB Graduate School
- With a General Weighted Average of 2.0 or better
- Not employed in an institution that is engaged in health care for mothers, infants and pregnant women
 Current leadership role in a professional organization, a nutrition research publication, an affiliation to the academe or a research institution is preferred

2ND SEMESTER - December 31

Terms of Scholarship

- 1. Dissertation / Thesis grant is open to students with an existing scholarship grant, provided that the applicant secures a certificate of approval to avail of the Nestlé Post-Graduate Nutrition Scholarship from the existing grantor;
- 2. Scholar shall enter into a scholarship agreement with Nestlé Philippines, Inc.;
- 3. Scholar shall maintain a GWA of 2.0 or better, and a passing grade in all subjects every semester;
- 4. Dissertation / thesis topic shall not cover topics on infant (0 to <12 months), young child (12 to 36 months) and maternal (pregnant and lactating) health and nutrition;
- 5. Upon graduation of the grantee, Nestlé Philippines, Inc. may engage the scholar as a consultant, researcher, or in any other related expert service, for such length of time equivalent to the time the grantee availed of the scholarship;
- 6. Repayment of the scholarship grant with interest shall be required from the scholar if the scholarship is terminated prematurely due to failure to comply with the terms and conditions of the scholarship.
