MECHANICS

The Contest is a partnership between the Nutritionist-Dietitians' Association of the Philippines (NDAP) and Nestlé Philippines, Inc. (NPI), NDAP and NPI hereinafter shall be jointly referred to as "Contest Facilitators". Nutrition colleges and universities in the Philippines can participate in the contest (the "Participating School").

- 1. The Participating Schools must accomplish the Registration Form and send a PDF copy to the NDAP Secretariat (secretariat_ndap@yahoo.com) on or before January 31, 2025.
- 2. Each Participating School will be allowed to submit a maximum of three (3) entries. The entries from the same school should be of different themes (see themes in item 4.b). Each entry can be submitted by a group composed of a maximum of five (5) members.
- 3. The members of the group must be above eighteen (18) years old, bona fide Nutrition undergraduate students and enrolled in a Nutrition course in the Participating School at the time of the submission as attested to by a nutrition school faculty member, who will sign in the registration form.
- 4. Entries for the video shall apply the following guidelines:
 - a. The recipe video should advocate the goodness of homemade cooking to bring tasty and balanced diet to Filipino families.
 - b. The theme can be one (1) of the following:
 - i. Main dish
 - ii. Snacks, baon, or on-the-go meals
 - iii. Celebrations
 - c. The recipe should use at least two (2) NESTLÉ products as follows: BEAR BRAND Powder or RTD, MILO Powder or RTD, CHUCKIE, NESTLÉ Fresh Milk, NIDO Nutrisnax, NESCAFÉ, NESTEA, KOKO KRUNCH, FITNESS, NESTLÉ Corn Flakes, MAGGI, NESTLÉ All Purpose Cream, and CARNATION. NESTLÉ products must be well incorporated in the recipe considering flavor contribution, integration, and enhancement of the overall flavor of the dish.
 - d. The recipe should be good for a family of four (4) members and with a maximum cost of Php 400.00 exclusive of the cost of other food items to complete the PINGGANG PINOY®. The costing sheet shall be submitted together with the registration form.
 - e. The video should include the recipe preparation and cooking, plating to complete the PINGGANG PINOY®, and the summary of ingredients
 - f. Only the students who are members of the registered team shall prepare and cook the recipes.
 - g. The target audience of the video is the general public.
 - h. The video file shall be 90 seconds maximum duration, MP4 format, 1080p resolution, with supers and subtitles in English Language.
 - i. The Nutrition Masterclass logo shall appear on the upper right portion for the entire duration of the video. No other logo should appear in the video.
 - j. The video shall be uploaded in YouTube with privacy set as public. The link of the YouTube video together with the submitted registration form shall be sent to the NDAP Secretariat (secretariat_ndap@yahoo.com) on or before January 31, 2025. The NDAP Secretariat shall assign codes to
 - k. To maintain anonymity of Participating School's entries during judging, the video entries shall not include school identification (i.e. school name, logo, location). The codes will only be revealed after selecting the final winners.
 - Upon winning, the Participating School's name shall be added by the winners on the closing frame of the video with the following text "This video was developed by [Participating School] for www.nutritionmasterclass.com.ph".
 - m. The video and all portions thereof should not violate or infringe on any person's intellectual property rights. Videos should not contain third property logos, brands, or music, unless these belong to the public domain or are used with the consent of the copyright owner. Videos which violate or infringe on intellectual property rights of third persons shall automatically be disqualified. The Participating School and its students shall hold the Contest Facilitators free and harmless from any and all complaints, litigations, or claims by third parties due to infringement or violation of intellectual property rights.
 - n. The video should be clear and contain wholesome images, and should not have any obscene, vulgar, pornographic, hateful, threatening, racist, discriminatory, offensive, illegal or otherwise inappropriate content.
 - o. The video should not contain images of pregnant woman and children who are below three (3) years old.
 - p. For any third parties whose names or likeness are featured in the photo, participant should obtain the valid and binding written consent of such person to use his or her likeness in the manner contemplated herein.
 - q. Video entries that violate any of these rules shall automatically be removed or disqualified from joining the Contest.
- 5. The Contest Facilitators reserve the right to disqualify or remove an entry as they deem fit and just without need of any explanation and their decision on the matter shall be final.
- 6. The Participating Schools and students agree that NPI may make the winning videos, or any portion thereof, available on the Nutrition Masterclass website, www.nutritionmasterclass.com.ph and other Nestlé digital assets. Participating Schools and students grant NPI the perpetual, non-exclusive, worldwide, irrevocable right to use, display, publish, transmit, copy, make derivative works from, edit, alter, store, re-format, sell and sub-license the winning entries for such purpose without need of any compensation.
- 7. Criteria for judging are as follows:

TASTE & BALANCE Recipe is appetizing to the taste buds with ingredients complementing each other; presentation adheres to PINGGANG PINOY® recommendation	30%
APPEARANCE & PALATABILITY Visual appeal of the dish, including the arrangement of ingredients, plating skills, and attention to detail in garnishing	25%
ORIGINALITY Originality and uniqueness of the dish, including touches or twists that set it apart from traditional recipes	25%
VIDEO FORMAT & ORGANIZATION Adequate and high-quality visuals and audio, and uses a clean, neat and visually appealing layout	20%



- 9. Preliminary judging of eligible entries by a panel of judges consisting of the representatives from the Contest Facilitators will be from February 5, 2025. The top 20 entries will move to the Final Judging.
- 10. For the Final Judging, a panel of judges consisting of the representatives from the Contest Facilitators shall select the contest winners. The Final Judging will be on February 10, 2025. Four (4) video entries shall win. Participating Schools with two (2) or more entries may also win more than once.
- 11. The winners will be announced on February 20, 2025 during the NDAP 70th Annual Convention.

- 2. All participants will receive a certificate of participation signed by NDAP and NPI representatives.
